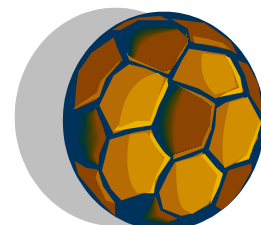

Tell the class about your partner's collection. Listen as he or she talks about what you collect, too.

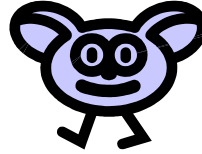

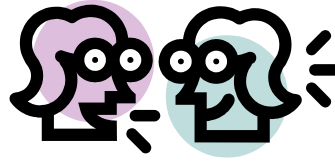
