# Assessments

- Policy D.100
  - Using the most up-to-date test administration manual
  - Follow the test administration procedures

## Status of grants

- State leadership, IELCE, and family literacy grants: Division Chief Review step completed
  - Most in rest of review process or completed
  - Some still with agencies for corrections
- 064 Adult Ed
  - 13 Division Chief Review step completed
  - 19 still in Division Chief Review

# Grant review process

- Process
  - Advisor reviews, adds internal comments
  - Fiscal reviews, adds internal comments
  - Division chief reviews, enters external comments, return grant to agency
    - Email to person listed as contact in eGrants under Administrative Functions>Contact Information
  - Once past Bureau Director Review, we have no control

## ▶ Fixing returned grants

- Read policies and guidelines
- Read comments carefully
- Discuss with your advisor
- Helpful for us: add comments in Message Board telling us the changes made
- Issues with eGrants
- Resubmit: Make sure correct person signs off before submission

# FERs

- Being reviewed: priority for those owed money or returning money
- Common error: submitted without sign off
  - “Returned for Correction–FER’ to ‘Review and Resubmit - FER’ via the Next Step button
  - Next, on the right side of Grant Application Detail page, within the Authorized Signoff area, there is a link for Final Expenditure Signoff



# eData

- Some changes/additions
- Testing PY 2018-19 eData
- Will open when testing is completed
- Individual agencies cannot enter data until grant is in Completed status

- Outcome measures for civics education programs
  - Same outcomes: achieved citizenship skills; register to vote; vote first time; increase involvement in community
  - Still need to set and document success
  - Guidelines, AB2

# Family literacy information

- End of year school report
  - Will add missing items to eData
  - Programs can collect information in any way that works for them and the teachers
  - Enter all data in eData
  - Do not send forms to eData Tech Support
