- Unexpended prior year state funds
- State 064, 054, 259
- Using data pulled 1/2/26, 6:00 PM
- 55% of contracted enrollment
  - 259: also 55% of contracted tutors
- TBD amount for each student w/1+ MSG
- Any allowable expenditures



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## ► Additional state funds

- Funds remaining after incentive funds
  - Increase in cost of current group insurance benefits
  - Increase in cost of rent for current classroom space
  - Registration & travel for 2026 PAACE conference
  - Registration & travel for 2026 PWDA conference
  - Additional hotspot access
  - Additional classes to address waiting lists

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## ► Section 243 IELCE grants

- Greater flexibility than prior grant cycles
- Integrated English Literacy and Civics Education activities required
- Flexibility in “providing access to IET”
- Encourage consortia



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## ► Performance Accountability Policy

- Purpose
  - Support the success of grantees and subgrantees
  - Early identification of potential agency performance-related issues
  - Support grantees with timely resolutions of those issues



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## ► Performance Accountability Policy: Criteria

- Accountability Criteria
  - Failure to meet performance targets based on state targets
  - Failure to be on track to meet the performance targets
    - Determined by performance criteria and percentages for enrollment and MSGs of the current program year for the 2026-27 grant continuation year



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## ► Performance Accountability Policy: Strategies

- Performance Intervention Strategies
  - Program Performance Improvement Plan (PPIP)
  - Individualized technical assistance
  - Frequent grant process reviews
  - Other interventions deemed necessary



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## ► Program Performance Improvement Plan (PPIP)

- Overview
  - Document that outline steps and actions grantees establish to correct areas of performance deficiency
  - SMART Goals
  - Root causes and barriers
  - Resources
  - Timelines
  - Feedback



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## ► Elements of the PPIP

- Challenge/Need Statement
- Objectives
- Activities (Actions)
- Responsible parties
- Outcomes
- Timeline
- Performance Measures/Evaluation Plan
- Budget and Funding Implications



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## ► PPIP vs. Correction Action Plan

- PPIP
  - Based on performance data and annual risk analysis, formal or targeted monitoring, or ongoing desk monitoring
  - Time-sensitive
  - Grant conditions



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## ► PPIP vs. Correction Action Plan (2)

- Correction Action Plan
  - Based on formal or targeted monitoring reviews and ongoing desk monitoring
  - Addresses actions related to findings and conditions of non-compliance discovered during a monitoring review
  - Not completed until all findings have been addressed



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### ► PPIP vs. Correction Action Plan Comparison

Feature	Program Performance Improvement Plan (PPIP)	Corrective Action Plan (CAP)
Purpose	To help the program get back on <b>track</b> .	To address non-compliance.
Cause	Lagging outcomes or missed benchmarks (e.g., enrollment, skill gains).	Findings based on review of agency documents and meetings with the agency and program staff.
Measure	Addresses failure to meet enrollment and performance targets.	Addresses specific compliance or management issues.
Ramifications	Conditions placed on grant if non-compliant items are not addressed. May impact funding	Conditions placed on grant if non-compliant items are not addressed. May impact funding
