

## Partnering & Collaborating

*Create “‘win-win’ relationships with all partners, an effort that requires genuine and active commitment to career pathway program goals and finding intersections among the individual and sometimes diverse goals of the partners”*

(Bragg, D., et al., 2007, p. 20)

**Questions to ask:** (get to know local agencies, other education providers, community-based organizations, employers, etc.)

- Who might partner with you?
- Who can productively partner with you?
- Who is willing to partner with you?
- What does each partner contribute?
- What role can each partner play?
- What role will each partner play?
- Who needs to know what you are doing? (doesn't mean that the organization needs to be involved but might be important for local support)

### Set Goals

- Overarching goal that everyone can agree upon and support
- Finite and concrete goals and accompanying steps
- Determine roles and responsibilities according to availability and resources (make sure not to overlap; be clear on who does what)
- Schedule regular meetings (single-partner and all-partner meetings)
  - Informational
  - Planning

**Strategic roles for partners:** For example...

- Access to new or difficult to reach populations (e.g., local church or community center)
- Input on programming (e.g., review curriculum, student placement, student services, disability services, instruction, certificate development, employee feedback)
- Fill in services or expertise (e.g., linguistic issues, advertising, case management)
