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GEER grants

- Division reviewing them
- Staff paid from GEER funds must have time and effort
- Expenditures must be for COVID mitigation, ensure continuity of services
 - Student recruitment not allowed
 - General office and class supplies that are not necessary for remote learning or to address health and safety not allowed




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Local match

- Must have documentation of it in addition to tracking it
- Must have process to determine fair-market value of in-kind donations




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Reminders and clarification


- Change in compulsory school age effective July 1, 2020
- Provision of services during COVID-19
 - Health and safety of staff and students
 - Division is NOT requiring in person services
