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Update and clarification

- BEST Plus 2.0
 - Can pair computer-adaptive with paper-based
 - Change needs to be made in eData
- Volunteer instructional staff
 - Classroom aide: under direction of classroom instructor
 - Tutors: one-on-one or small group (max 6)
 - Classroom instructor: class with 7 or more students on roster
 - These volunteers must meet all requirements as paid classroom instructors
- L&I Digital Literacy and Workforce Development Grants
