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Adult education enrollment

- Statewide – 34.6% of contracted
 - >50% - 6 grantees
 - 40-50% - 4 grantees
 - 30-40% - 6 grantees
 - 20-30% - 7 grantees
 - <20% - 8 grantees



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Adult education retention

- Statewide – 49.48 hours
 - >50 hrs. – 12 grantees
 - 40-50 hrs. – 9 grantees
 - 30-40 hrs. – 7 grantees
 - 25-30 hrs. – 1 grantee
 - 20-25 hrs. – 2 grantees
 - <20 hrs. – none



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Adult education EFL gain (Table 4)

- Statewide 17%
 - >50% - 0 grantees
 - 40-50% - 3 grantees
 - 30-40% - 0 grantees
 - 20-30% - 3 grantees
 - 10-20% - 15 grantees
 - 1-10% - 10 grantees



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Adult education EFL gain (Table 4B)

- Statewide
 - 32% of participants have been posttested
 - 53.87% of the posttested participants have an EFL gain
 - 22 grantees (of 31) have posttested 20 or more participants
 - >65% EFL – 5 grantees
 - 50-65% EFL – 7 grantees
 - 30-50% EFL – 10 grantees




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Family literacy enrollment


- Enrollment
 - >40% - 4 agencies
 - 30-40% - 5 agencies
 - 20-30% - 3 agencies
 - <20% - 3 agencies

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Family literacy average parent ed hours


- Parent education average hours
 - >30 hours – 1 agency
 - 20-30 hours – 0 agencies
 - 10-20 hours – 5 agencies
 - <10 hours – 9 agencies

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Family literacy average ILA hours


- ILA average hours
 - >30 hours – 0 agencies
 - 20-30 hours – 2 agencies
 - 10-20 hours – 6 agencies
 - <10 hours – 7 agencies

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Family literacy EFL gains


- Number of adults with an EFL gain
 - >10 – 0 agencies
 - 6-10 – 1 agency
 - 1-5 – 9 agencies
 - 0 – 5 agencies

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Preparing for 2021 22

- No more exceptions for
 - Pretest >30 days after program year start date
 - FL children must have ECE
- Determine program improvement activities
 - How will you rebuild the program?
 - Ongoing use of distance learning and virtual services
