Strategies	Resources
Allow students to attend via Zoom or in-class, whichever is most convenient. Notice better attendance in Zoom.	<b>Ultimate Phonics</b> - App to teach decoding. The first 50 lessons are free. <a href="http://www.spencerlearning.com">www.spencerlearning.com</a>
Share documents online - Use LMS (ex: Google Classroom, Schoology).	<b>Padlet</b> - Share resources. Students can contribute to it.
Develop a podcast (advanced ESL students) - speaking and writing (scripts).	<b>ESL library</b> - At home and in the classroom
Spot the difference (between two photos).	<b>Bamboozle</b> - Games with a quiz-show format
Six-word stories – Use six words to summarize the lesson.	<b>Learning Chocolate</b> - Pronunciation
Class starts with a picture write. Then they go into breakout rooms for five minutes to discuss their writing and come back and discuss as a whole group.	<a href="#">Sample activities for Jamboard, Padlet, and pre-recorded videos</a>
