The Division of Adult Education administers federal state and local adult literacy, basic skills, and family literacy programs in Pennsylvania. The Division of Adult Education provides adult literacy, basic skills, and family literacy programs to eligible individuals who are 16 years of age or older and are unable to read, write, or perform basic math skills. The Division of Adult Education also provides high school equivalency testing, counseling, and career development services for adult students and family literacy program staff, including training for volunteer tutors of adult students.
